I greet you in the powerful and faithful name of Christ Jesus. As we  
continue to work together to fulfill our \$3 million commitment to save the lives of  
300,000 of our brothers and sisters who run the risk of dying on this day  
because of Malaria, I wanted to make sure you had the **most recent report**  
**(1/31/16)**.

As I have prayerfully studied our INM giving report I was moved by the  
many churches who have clearly given sacrificially. Thank you. I need to also  
say, however, how disappointed I was to see that over 70 of our churches have  
given not even a penny. Perhaps some of you just haven't sent in your  
contribution or you are working on it right now. Please  
do your very best to help us fight Malaria and save  
precious lives.
